During the validity of the contract, the CMP shall be at liberty to terminate the contract for betterment of his/her carrier or on any other ground by giving 15 days notice to the Railways. The contract can also be terminated by the Railways at any time during the contract by giving 15 days notice without assigning any reasons whatsoever. Contract shall also be terminated if the CMP is found to be mentally or physically incapacitated.
