MEMBER OPERATIONS & BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT, RAILWAY BOARD VISITS SER HEADQUARTERS AND REVIEWS THE PERFORMANCE OF OPERATING AND COMMERCIAL DEPARTMENTS

Sri Ravinder Goyal, Member Operations & Business Development, Railway Board visited South Eastern Railway (SER) Headquarters, Garden Reach on 18.07.2024 and held high level meeting to review the performance of Operating and Commercial Departments of South Eastern Railway, Eastern Railway and Metro Railway. Sri Deepak Kumar Jha, Principal Chief Operations Manager, SER, Sri Upinder Singh, Principal Chief Commercial Manager, SER and other senior Traffic Officers were present in the meeting held with South Eastern Railway.

Sri Goyal had detailed discussion with Sri Anil Kumar Mishra, General Manager, South Eastern Railway regarding different ongoing projects and laid emphasis on timely completion of projects like new line, doubling, third line, road over bridge, passenger amenity works etc. Discussions were also held to enhance passenger safety and security.

During the Meeting, Sri Goyal reviewed the different aspects of railway operations and laid special emphasis on safety, punctuality, freight loading and earnings. He expressed satisfaction about the all round performance of SER and stressed on the timely completion of developmental works. Detailed discussions were held on achieving the freight loading target in 2024-25, increasing the maximum permissible speed of freight

trains, completion of new line/doubling works, different traffic facility works etc.

Earlier, Sri Deepak Kumar Jha, Principal Chief Operations Manager, South Eastern Railway apprised Member, Operations & Business Development, Railway Board about the achievements and key activities of SER in the year 2023-24. In the last financial year, SER loaded 211.60 million tonnes of freight which was the best ever loading performance of this railway since its trifurcation in 2003. In the current financial year, SER has loaded 52.33 million tonnes in the first quarter, an incremental growth of 3.75%. Sri Goyal suggested some improvement measures during the meeting and appreciated the overall performance of South Eastern Railway.

Later, Sri Ravinder Goyal, Member Operations & Business Development also held meetings with Eastern Railway and Metro Railway at SER Headquarters today to review the performance of respective zones. Sri Saumitra Biswas, Principal Chief Operations Manager, Eastern Railway, Sri Soumitra Majumdar, Principal Chief Commercial Manager, Eastern Railway and Sri Laksheswar Saikia, Principal Chief Operations Manager, Metro Railway and other senior officers were present.

He has assured all possible support to South Eastern Railway regarding medical services and infrastructure.

SOUTH EASTERN RAILWAY CELEBRATES 78th INDEPENDENCE DAY

The 78th Independence Day was celebrated at South Eastern Railway Headquarters, Garden Reach with due solemnity. Shri Anil Kumar Mishra, General Manager, South Eastern Railway hoisted the National Flag and took salute at the ceremonial parade presented by the contingents of Railway Protection Force, Civil Defence, St. John Ambulance Brigade and Bharat Scouts & Guides. On the Independence Day, the General Manager conveyed his greetings to all.

[[Highlighting the achievements of SER in recent times, General Manager said that South Eastern Railway, popularly known as the Blue Chip Railway, is among the top freight loading zones of Indian Railways. In 2023-24, S E Railway loaded 211.6 million tonnes of freight which is 4.44% more than the previous year. During the period from April to July 2024, SER achieved a commendable loading of 70.32 million tonnes of freight which is about 5.32% higher than the corresponding period of 2023-24. General Manager added that in order to increase operational capacity, 155km of doubling/3rd line work has been completed so far this year.

General Manager stated that with a view to provide more amenities to the passengers, 20 lifts and 10 escalators have been commissioned at various stations during the current financial year. Moreover, to ensure safety and convenience of the passengers, the work of 39 Foot Over Bridges have been completed this year so far. These apart, raising of height at 36 platforms and increase in length of 34 platforms have been completed and 87 platform sheds have been constructed at different stations. During the current financial year, 485 special trains have been run to clear the extra rush of the passengers.

Safety of passengers is of paramount importance and as a major step towards free from level crossing, SER has completed the construction work of 6 Road Over Bridges. Moreover, 17 level crossings have been eliminated in the last financial year and upto July, 2024.

5 pairs of Vande Bharat Express trains have been introduced in financial year 2023-24. He added that 72 stations of SER are being developed under Amrit Bharat Station Scheme and 108 stalls and 48 trolleys have been made operational at different stations of South Eastern Railway under "One Station One Product" scheme.

Mentioning the special efforts of RPF, General Manager stated that this year under "Operation Nanhe Farishtey", total 982 children have been rescued from train and station premises and handed over to Child Line or their family members. RPF personnel of South Eastern Railway in "Operation Jeevan Raksha", saved the precious lives of 63 passengers by risking their own lives.

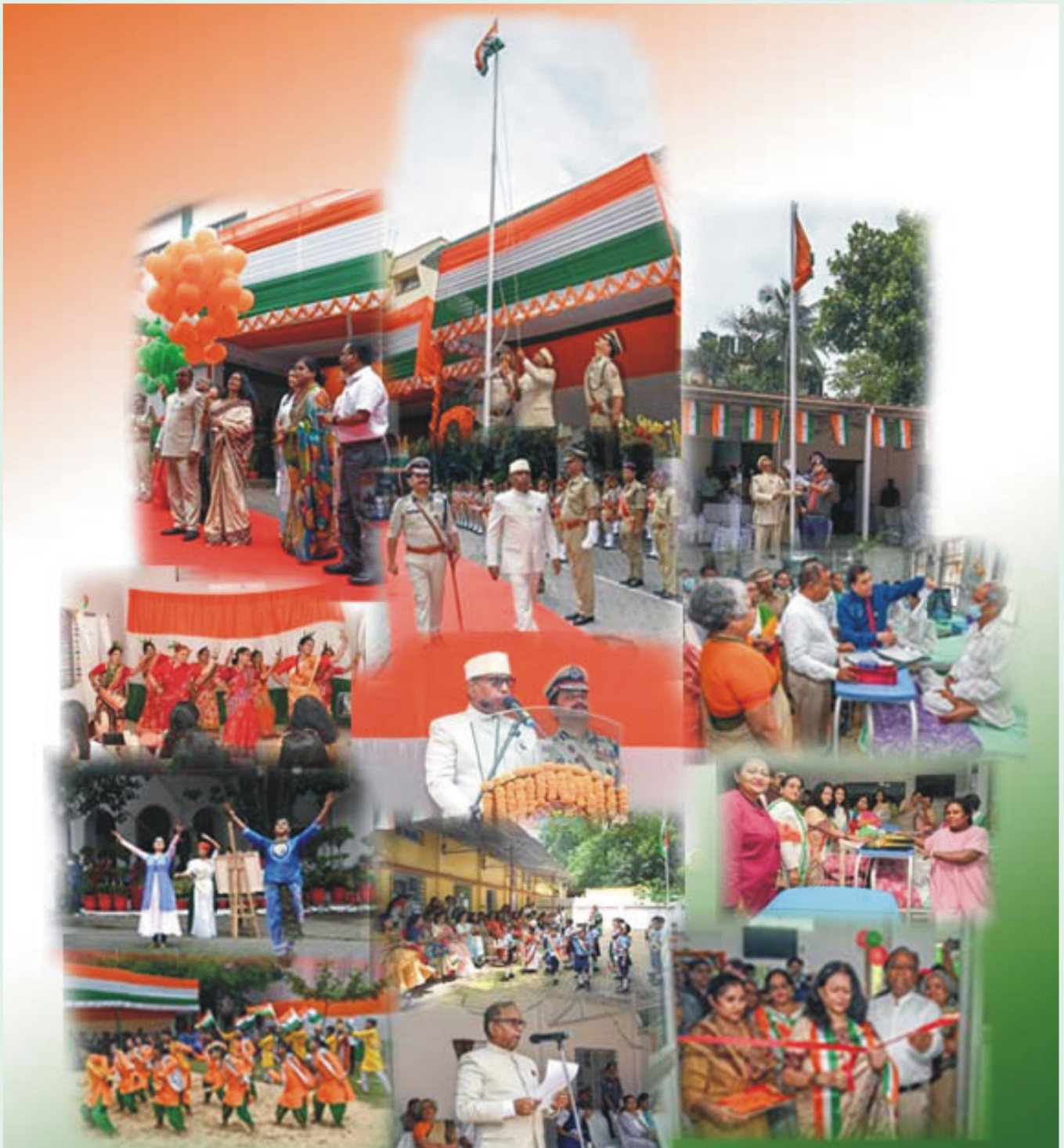
