During a preventive check conducted by Railway Vigilance with regard to Medical Memos issued by RRBs for medical examination of Open market Direct Recruitment candidates, it was noticed that the same were being issued with vague medical category like A1 and below in spite of having pre-defined/notified medical category. The matter has been considered and in consultation with Health Directorate, it has been decided that:-

- (a) Medical memos issued by RRBs should mention each post and medical classification of each post so as to include all the posts for which candidate has applied and is to be examined. The nomenclature written in medical memos shall be Aye One and not A1, Bee One and not B1 and so on;
- (b) Medical officer issuing fitness/unfit should specifically mention medical classification and post/posts for which candidate is found fit; and
- (c) The Medical Examiner will clearly mention medical classification/ classifications and post/posts for which the candidate is unfit and confine himself only to medical classification/post for which candidate is sent for medical examination.

2. All RRBs are directed to generate Medical Memos through Online Indenting and Recruitment Management System(OIRMS) including Photographs and signature of the candidates for all future recruitments notified in 2019 and onwards. These Medical memos shall be forwarded to the concerned Railway Hospitals/Divisional Health Units through the System only.


