Minutes of the meeting conducted with public representative for spreading the guidelines of NGT among the Rail users issued for Railway.

(1) AT Tatanagar Railway Station: Meeting headed by ARM, TATA

The said meeting has been conducted on **14/10/2019** and the following public representatives were present in the meeting.

At the outset, ARM/TATA welcomed the public representative and described the essence of the meeting. ARM, TATA informed the members about the programme being undertaken by CKP Division to implement the guidelines of NGT issued for Railway. He stated that due to continuous joint effort by Railway, NGO and public representatives, Tatanagar station able to grab highest cleaning score over South Eastern Railway. Further, ARM, TATA requested to members to help Railway officials of Tatanagar station in educating the Rail users about the importance of clean and green India by holding campaign at regular interval and members agreed to join the hands of Railway for this noble cause.

Members suggested implementing the following at ground level.

1	Public representative taken oath for complete eradication of polythene bags and thermocol items from station premises which are environment hazard
2	Members stressed upon for disposal of garbage in accordance with NGT's guidelines. ARM assured that Railway is in regular touch with local Municipal corporation and Jusco authority for the said purpose. This apart, CKP division is going to set up its own garbage decompose plant to overcome from this menace.
3	Sri Ranjeet Prasad, Professor, NIT stated that NIT, Adityapur is ready to provide technical assistance for recycling of plastic bottles at Tatanagar. ARM appreciated the move and assured that Railway will visit NIT, Adityapur shortly.
4	Inner Wheel Club expressed their willingness to undertake work of development of green belt and other beautification work subject to offer suitable space by Railway. President also assured that within one month, they will provide potted plant for Tatanagar Railway station. ARM appreciated the move
5	Dr. Maheswar Prasad, Civil Surgeon requested to launch frequent drive against the nuisance creator and give wide publicity through various Media coverage. ARM stated that Railway is planning to enhance CCTV to curb this menace.
6	All the members given their consent in participation of drives against use of polythene bags.
7	Members requested to involve media for wide coverage of all the activities being undertaken by Railway to make the station green and clean.

8	Members requested to organize plantation programme at regular intervals on all the vacant land of Tatanagar Railway station.
9	Members suggested to colour all the flower and plant pots with green colour and may paste the cleaning slogans on it. It will help to create awareness. ARM welcomed the suggestion and assured that the same will be complied within a week or two.
10	Members suggested to put Eco friendly, bio-degradable and non biodegradable dustbins at the station. ARM stated that procurement is under process. He also requested the members to explore the donation.

ARM, TATA assured that all the suggestions will be adhered to promptly and Railway will try to expedite the early completion of ongoing projects pertaining to NGT. ARM, requested the members to join the hands of Railway to make the station green & clean and polythene free which is environmental hazard. ARM/TATA stated that all the defective bottle crusher machine have been rectified and now these are functional.

(2) AT Chakradharpur Railway station: Meeting headed by ACM, CKP.

At the outset, ACM/CKP welcomed the public representative and described the essence of the meeting. The meeting has been conducted in order to seek assistance from the local NGO's to create awareness among the general public and rail users for complete ban on single use plastic and thermocol and to implement the other guidelines of NGT in the effective manner. ACM, CKP informed the members about the various NGT base projects of Railway planned by CKP Division. Further, ACM, CKP requested to members to help Railway officials of Chakradharpur station in educating the Rail users about the importance of clean and green surroundings by holding time to time campaign and members agreed to join the hands of Railway for this noble cause.

Members asked the Railway to work on the following points which will definitely help the Railway to educate the users.

1	Members requested to provide vacant and unused land of Railway so that their team could do plantation work at regular interval.
2	Members suggested to encourage the stall operators to promote Kulhar at the station. It will help in to complete eradication of plastic items.
3	Members suggested to paste sticker on bottle crusher machine indicating it is only meant for disposal of plastic bottle. Avoid to drop other plastic material as it may defunct the machine. It will help to educate the passengers.
4	Littering drive to be sensitized more and wide publicity through media is required.
5	Suggested to put Eco friendly dustbins at the station with cleaning slogans.

ACM/CKP stated that all the valuable suggestion received during the meeting from public representative will be adhered to by the Railway on priority basis. After meeting, shramdan has also been organized in presence of all public representatives.

(3) AT Jharsuguda Railway Station: Meeting headed by ARM, JSG

Members suggested to implement the following at ground level.

1	Members suggested to put boards indicating that Jharsuguda station is plastic free station and carrying of plastic bags is a punishable offence. ARM assured that it will be complied shortly.
2	Members requested to promote Kulhar at the station. All tea stall must have kulhar for serving tea.
3	Advised to encourage the Safai Karmchari and arrange to facilitate them as they are key performer.
4	All Railway staff must carry metal bottle for drinking water. Plastic bottles should be avoided by Railway staff. Example should be set up from front.
5	As per waste management, segregation of waste should be done at source point. Project manager of Mechanized cleaning asked to implement it immediately.
6	Members requested to provide Eco-friendly dustbins with clear indication of bio-degradable and non-biodegradable waste collection bin
7	Cleaning awareness campaign should be continued and should be launched atleast once in a week in addition to plantation programme.

ARM, JSG assured that all the suggestions will be adhered to promptly. ARM, JSG glad to inform all the members that Sri Pratap Chandra Sarangi, Minister of States under Bharat Sarkar has offered massive Shramdan at JSG station which is a great example for all of us and requested all the members to ensure their auspicious presence at the time of awareness campaign so that message could spread to all corners.

**Agenda of the Meeting was – (i) Solid Waste Management
(ii) Plastic Waste Management
(iii) Segregation of plastic at garbage generation sources
(iv) Disposal/Recycle of garbage after segregation**

At the outset of the meeting, SMR, ROU welcome all the officials and members and described the importance of “Solid waste Management” 2016 and “Plastic waste Management” and its value in daily existence. ARM, BNNDM requested to project manager to implement the work of segregation of garbage at source point itself and dump at the nominated point so that local municipality could lift for further disposal in accordance with NGT guidelines. ARM also requested to all members to help Rourkela station authority in developing the green belt and in promoting women health and hygiene. He also requested the members to explore the possibility of donation of Eco-friendly dustbins so that garbage could be collected in segregated manner. Members assured for help.

Members suggested to implement the following at ground level.

1	Identification of site for keeping the waste in segregated manner for further lifting by Municipality. ARM stated that space has already been identified near abandoned goods cabin until final set up is not become ready.
2	Members requested to promote Kulhar at the station. All tea stall must have kulhar for serving tea. Catering Inspector to be involved for the said purpose. ARM assured that the same will be ensured.
3	Advised to conduct monthly meeting with review to ensure the implementation of NGT guidelines in effective manner.
4	Advised to increase the number of pet bottle crusher machine as present strength is not enough to handle the volume of plastic born garbage. ARM requested members to encourage the welfare organization for donation of the same. However, Railway is also making the procurement process.
5	Suggested to put sticker on dustbins with cleanliness slogans. It will help to educate the passengers.
6	All the catering stall must put board that his stall is plastic free. ARM assured that the same will be implemented within a week or two.
7	Plantation programme to be launched at regular interval with wide media coverage.

ARM, BNDM assured that all the suggestions will be adhered to promptly. ARM, BNDM also stated that CKP division is planning to set up decompose plant to reduce the dependency on other organization. ARM, requested the members to join the hands of Railway to make the station green & clean and polythene free which is environmental hazard.

Further, ARM, BNDM requested to members to help Railway officials of Rourkela station in educating the Rail users about the importance of clean and green surroundings by holding time to time awareness campaign and members agreed to share their shoulder for this noble cause.

Commercial department, Chakradharpur is taking more initiatives to implement the guidelines of NGT issued for Railway and efforts are also being made to create awareness among the Rail users.
