Minutes of the meeting conducted with public representative for creating awareness among the Rail users pertaining to implementation of guidelines of NGT.

(1) AT Tatanagar Railway Station: Meeting headed by Station Director, TATA

The said meeting has been conducted on **08/11/2019** and the following public representatives were present in the meeting.

At the outset, Station Director/TATA welcomed the public representative and described the essence of the meeting. Station Director, TATA informed the members about the programme being undertaken by CKP Division to implement the guidelines of NGT issued for Railway. He stated that due to continuous joint effort by Railway, NGO and public representatives, Tatanagar station is able to maintain high quality of cleanliness. Further, Station Director, TATA requested to members to help Railway officials of Tatanagar station in educating the Rail users about the importance of clean and green India by holding campaign at regular interval and members agreed to join the hands of Railway.

Members suggested implementing the following at ground level.

1	All the members stressed upon to have systematic garbage disposal mechanism so that collected garbage may be disposed off in accordance with guidelines of NGT. Station Director, TATA stated that Railway is continuously holding meeting with Municipal team to make this provision until Railway creates its own arrangement. SD/TATA assured members that CKP division will set up shortly its own garbage disposal plant.
2	Smt. Manju Singh, President, Inner Inner Wheel Club, Jamshedpur assured that her team will donate twenty nos. of potted plant and also stated that they will help Railway for developing green belt, if proper Railway land is provided to them. Members applauded her move.
3	Dr. Arun Kumar Tiwary expressed his willingness to call him whenever Railway organizes the public awareness programme. His team will participate. SD, TATA assured him.
4	All the public representative requested to launch frequent drive against use of polythene bags at station. SD, TATA assured that members will also be involved.
5	Members also suggested involving media to give wide coverage of all public awareness programmes as it will help to spread awareness among the passengers.
6	Members requested to organize plantation programme at regular intervals on all the vacant land of Tatanagar Railway station. SD, TATA assured that members will be informed time to time.

7	Members also suggested painting the flower pots or pasting the pictorial guidance on the pot. It will help to create awareness. Station Director welcomed the suggestion and assured that the same will be complied within a week or two.
8	Members suggested to place Eco friendly, bio-degradable and non biodegradable dustbins at the station. SD, TATA stated that procurement is under process. SD, TATA also requested the members to explore the donation under CSR initiative.
9	Members emphasized on littering cases and requested to extend the CCTV surveillance

Station Director, TATA assured that all the suggestions will be adhered to promptly and Railway will try to expedite the early completion of ongoing projects pertaining to NGT.

2	Kulhar must be promoted at the station. It will help in complete eradication of plastic items. DCM (TC & PA)/CKP assured that Railway is working on it.
3	Member of Adivasi Sanskrit Vidyalaya requested to organize Prabhat pheri on regular interval in Railway area and requested to allow her team for this noble purpose. DCM (TC & PA)/CKP assured that message will be conveyed in advance.
4	Members requested for distribution of pamphlet. Considering their request, DCM (TC & PA)/CKP organized the same after over the meeting and all the members participated in awareness campaign and distributed the pamphlet supplied by HQ

DCM (TC & PA)/CKP stated that all the valuable suggestion received during the meeting from public representative will be adhered to by the Railway on priority basis. After meeting, pamphlets distributed by the members.

At the outset, Sri S. B. Tripathy, Station Manager/JSG welcomed all the public representatives and requested for sparing their valuable time for this noble cause. ARM, JSG addressed all the officials and public representatives and emphasized on complete eradication of poly bags and thermocol from station area and to improve the ambience of the station. ARM, JSG stressed upon implementation of 3Rs, Recycle, Reuse and Refuse of plastic.

Members suggested to implement the following at ground level.

1	Members applauded the move of Railway for allowing Kulhar at the catering stall and requested to continue the same. ARM/JSG assured that it will keep continue.
2	Members requested to paste pictorial guidance on all the dustbins provided at Jharsuguda station which is one of the effective steps to educate the passengers. ARM/JSG assured that the same will be completed within a week or two.
3	Members requested to encourage private agency for developing green patches at the station and circulating area to improve the travelling experience of the passengers. ARM stated that matter will be looked into.
4	Members suggested to place atleast two flower pots in front of each catering units. ARM/JSG assured that the same will be completed within a week or two.
5	As per waste management, segregation of waste should be done at source point. Project manager of Mechanized cleaning asked to implement it immediately. The same point was raised in last meeting also. Project Manager assured that it will be started within a day or two.

ARM, JSG assured that all the suggestions will be adhered to promptly. ARM, JSG assured that all the suggestions will be adhered to promptly and Railway will try to expedite the early completion of ongoing projects pertaining to NGT.

(4) AT Rourkela Railway Station: Meeting headed by ARM, BNDM

**Agenda of the Meeting was – (i) Disposal of garbage generated from station and Catering stall
(ii) Development of Green Patches
(iii) Launching of Signature Campaign
(iv) Swachhta and no use of single plastic items.**

At the outset of the meeting, SMR, ROU welcome all the officials and members and described the importance of “proper disposal of garbage and development of green belt” and its value in daily existence. ARM, BNDM requested to project manager to implement the work of segregation of garbage at source point itself as it is not being implemented in effective manner. The collected garbage must be dumped at the nominated point so that local municipality could lift for further disposal in accordance with NGT guidelines. ARM also requested to all members to help Rourkela station authority in developing the green belt and in promoting women health and hygiene. ARM requested the members and railway officials for active participation in Swachhta signature campaign.

Members suggested to implement the following at ground level.

1	It has been unanimously decided to provide pictorial guidance on all the dustbins available at Rourkela station for which a target date has been fixed to complete this project. CHI has been advised to ensure the same within a week or two.
2	Project Manager has been advised to increase the number of garbage collection trolley and also requested to increase the frequency of collection as present system of collection is not good enough. As per waste management, segregation of waste should be done at source point. Project manager of Mechanized cleaning asked to implement it immediately.
3	Rourkela Municipal Official requested to provide one micro composite centre for bio waste exclusively for Railway until Railway creates its own arrangement.
4	Advised to increase the number of pet bottle crusher machine as present strength is not enough to handle the volume of plastic born garbage. ARM requested members to encourage the welfare organization for donation of the same. However, Railway is also making the procurement process.
5	Private agencies to whom various works awarded requested for development of green patches in circulating area.
6	All the catering units are requested for active participation in plantation programme. Agreed to donate ten plants by each catering units.
7	Stray Dogs/Cattle to be removed in association with Municipal Corporation, Rourkela under ABC programme and RFID scheme respectively.
8	Members requested to Railway to provide cattle guard at all the entry point of station to restrict the entry of cattle. RMC shared the toll free number 18003456103 meant for controlling the cattle.

ARM, BNDM assured that all the suggestions will be adhered to promptly. ARM, BNDM also stated that CKP division is planning to set up decompose plant to reduce the dependency

on other organizations. ARM, requested the members to join the hands of Railway to make the station green & clean and polythene free which is environmental hazard.

Further, ARM, BNDM requested to members to help Railway officials of Rourkela station in educating the Rail users and requested to come forward and participate in signature campaign. All the members accepted the proposal and agreed to share their shoulder for this noble cause.

Commercial department, Chakradharpur is taking more initiatives to implement the guidelines of NGT issued for Railway and efforts are also being made to create awareness among the Rail users. Signature campaign in this regard has also launched at all these four stations. As desired during video conference, different dates for organizing the drama and Nukkad Natak by the people of Divisional Cultural Association and Bharat Scouts & Guides has been fixed and also informed the matter to CPRO for sending his team to witness the said programme and for giving the wide coverage of this programme.
