SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

A) In terms of Railway Board's letter No. E(GP)2018/2/31 dated 19.03.2019(RBE 53/2019) the written examination will comprise of one Paper which will have **100% Objective type Multiple choice Questions** only with negative marking @1/3 of the marks allotted for each question will be deducted for each wrong answer. The paper will be of **100 marks** and distribution will be as under:

- i. Technical Subject including Official language policy : 70 marks
(NOTE: There will be 10 marks on Official Language Policy, which shall be optional in nature).
- ii. Establishment and Financial Rules : 30 marks
- iii. **Qualifying marks:** : 60 (out of 100)

The successful candidates in the written examination will be called for viva-voce test subject to being found medically fit in the prescribed medical standard.

B) Record of Service and Viva-voce:

Pre-selection training: Prior to written test pre-selection training for a period of 3-4 weeks to the SC reserved community candidates only should be arranged by the Executive side. This training be treated as mandatory and refusal, if any, should be taken in writing and kept for record.

Date of written test: The exact date of the written test will be announced after receipt the completion report of the pre-selection training.

Concerted effort should be taken to ensure that this notice is reached to all the candidates. In case any candidate is on leave or on deputation to other Railways/Units or on sick list, the Controlling Officer concerned should send necessary advice to the authority under whom he/she is working or the Medical Authority as the case may be and an acknowledgement obtained.

The Controlling Officers, Sr.DPOs /DPOs should ensure that the ACRs of the candidates who have volunteered for the above examination, for the last 5 years complete in all respects is available with him and be sent to Dy.CPO(Gaz) at a short notice. It is the responsibility of the Controlling/Staff Officer that if any adverse remarks or the point below the bench mark in the ACR of any candidate is detected, the same should be informed to the candidate and dispose the representation, if received, immediately.
