

SOUTH EASTERN RAILWAY'S ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE MONTH OF MAY 2021

- In order to meet the nationwide demand of Liquid Medical Oxygen (LMO), South Eastern Railway has been running Oxygen Express Trains since 23rd April, 2021 from Tatanagar, Rourkela and Bokaro Steel City. Till the end of May 2021, S E Railway has dispatched 173 Oxygen Trains containing 12,354 MT of LMO in 806 containers/tankers. These Oxygen Express Trains have been run as per the requirements of various States and have helped to bring relief to the COVID-19 affected patients in different parts of the country. So far, LMO has been sent to 12 States and Union Territories viz. Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Assam, Haryana, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, Kerala, Punjab and Delhi.
- South Eastern Railway in the month of May 2021 has run 2117 Mail/Express Special Trains, 926 Holiday Special Trains and 149 COVID-19 Parcel Express Trains.
- SER in the month of May 2021 has loaded 16.21 million tonnes of freight against 10.00 million tonnes loaded in May 2020 registering a growth of 62%. Revenue generation from freight loading in May 2021 has been Rs.1,383.41 crores as against Rs.785.27 crores generated in the month of May 2020.
- During COVID-19 pandemic situation, Personnel Branch of Adra Division has taken initiative to distribute medicine kits to the COVID-19 affected employees and their family members. The medicine kits consist of 10 indispensable medicines as per prescription of Jharkhand State Health Department. The process of distribution has started from 17th May, 2021.
- Massive awareness drive against COVID-19 has been conducted by the members of Bharat Scouts & Guides of Kharagpur Division during May 2021. Masks were distributed and Nukkad Natak was performed as a part of this awareness drive. A blood donation camp was also organised on 10th May, 2021 to meet the crisis for Thalassemia patients.

- In view of cyclone “YAAS” which hit the coastal areas of West Bengal and Odisha on 26th May, 2021, enquiry counters, refund counters and help desks were opened at major locations. 44 stranded passengers in Hatia-Rourkela section were brought safely to Rourkela by road and they were served with food packets and packaged drinking water. Similarly 120 persons were provided with food and drinking water at different stations of Kharagpur Division viz. Kolaghat, Kharagpur, Fuleswar and Radhamohanpur.
- As a safety initiative, one manned level crossing has been eliminated in Chakradharpur Division (Rajkharswan-Dangoaposi Section) by constructing Limited Height Subway in May 2021.
- A total number of 24,507 beneficiaries were vaccinated in SER zone during the month of May 2021. Altogether 4,679 samples were sent for COVID-19 testing during the month and 1934 cases were found positive.
- 9 minor girls and 15 minor boys were rescued by RPF personnel during May 2021 and were handed over to their respective parents or Child Help Line.
