2. Brief of activities carried out:

- (a) To protect and safeguard railway property and to combat crime against it.
- (b) To remove any obstruction in the movement of railway property.
- (c) To aid, co-operate and co-ordinate the measures of other railway agencies or the police or other authorities in implementing other appropriate measures for ensuring prevention of crime against the railway property and providing for its better security;
- (d) To collect intelligence about subversive and other objectionable activities affecting the security and functioning of the railways as well as the activities of criminals and suspects prying on railway property.
- (e) To assist the commercial and other departments of the railway during raids on ticket less travelers, alarm chain pullers, unauthorized hawkers and on those indulging in, hose pipe disconnections or infringing other provisions of the Indian Railways Act, 1980; .
- (f) To guard cash office of railway and escort their pay clerks;.
- (g) To take prompt measures to procure necessary medical help for any wounded or sick person under the arrest or in custody;
- (h) Important Mail/express trains including Rajdhani & Duranto and EMU local trains are being escorted by RPF/RPSF & lady RPF personnel.
- (i) Mahila Vahini teams have been formed to escort the ladies compartment of EMU local trains and to stop crime against women.
- (j) Regular drives are being conducted in train & Rly. premises under Rly. Act. and erring persons are being prosecuted.
- (k) Creating awareness among passengers through PA system, loudhailers , Leaf let & posters are displayed at conspicuous places .
- (l) Videography of General compartments is being done at important stations. CCTV are functioning at SRC, KGP and MDN being monitored by RPF.
- (m) Task team has been formed time to time and functioning over Kharagpur division to prevent the passenger crime.
- (n) Toll Free RPF Help line (182) is also been introduced to facilitate the travelling passenger.
