

**SOUTH EASTERN RAILWAY'S ACHIEVEMENTS**  
**IN THE MONTH OF JULY 2021**

- Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav was celebrated on 28.07.2021 over South Eastern Railway jurisdiction. A cultural event on patriotic songs was organised by Divisional Cultural Association, Ranchi with all Covid protocols and social distancing. Similarly, a Walkathon was organised by Chakradharpur Division in association with South Eastern Railway Sports Association, Chakradharpur.
- As a part of major infrastructure developmental work, one Road Over Bridge in lieu of Level Crossing No. RBK-14 between Chaibasa-Singpokharia has been commissioned. This Road Over Bridge was inaugurated by Sri Hemant Soren, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Jharkhand on 29.07.2021.
- South Eastern Railway has despatched 4 Oxygen Express trains to Benapole in Bangladesh from Tatanagar in Chakradharpur Division during the month of July 2021. The first Oxygen Express train left Tatanagar carrying 200 tonnes of Liquid Medical Oxygen (LMO) in 10 Containers on 24.07.2021. The second, third and fourth Oxygen Express trains left for Bangladesh from Tatanagar on 27.07.2021, 29.07.2021 and 31.07.2021 respectively for the treatment of Covid affected patients.

In order to meet the growing demand of Oxygen for treatment of Covid affected patients, South Eastern Railway has been running Oxygen Express Trains since 23.04.2021 to different parts of the country to ensure quick transportation and smooth supply of Oxygen.

- South Eastern Railway has loaded 64.96 Million Tonnes of originating Freight in the first four months i.e. April to July of the current financial year (2021-22), registering a growth of 42.08% in comparison to the corresponding period of last financial year.

There is also a rise of 49.44% in originating freight revenue in comparison to the first four months of the last fiscal. During April to July 2021, the revenue generation from originating freight loading is Rs 5327.54 crores against Rs. 3565.03 crores in same period of the previous year.

The main commodities of Freight loading during the first four months of 2021-22 were Iron ore, Coal, Pig iron & Finished Steel, Cement, Fertilizer, Petroleum Products etc. SER has loaded 37.14 Million Tonnes of Iron ore during this period, which is 31% more than the corresponding period of previous fiscal.

During the month of July, 2021, SER loaded 16.68 million tonnes of freight as against 14.38 million tonnes loaded in July, 2020 registering

a growth of 15.99%. SER also surpassed the freight loading target of July by loading 5.70% more than the target.

- SER arranged to run 2705 Mail/Express Special Trains, 1307 Holiday Special Trains and 114 Covid -19 Parcel Express Trains in the month of July, 2021.
- Parcel Express Train 00803/00804 between Shalimar-Kollam-Shalimar was introduced w.e.f 12.07.2021.
- As a part of improvement of passenger amenities and facilities at stations, platform extension work of platform no. 2 at Kalunga station of Chakradharpur Division has been completed in the month of July, 2021. Moreover, platform no. 3 at Bankura station in Adra Division has been improved by providing Kota Stone Flooring.  
The first prefabricated toilet in South Eastern Railway has been constructed through CSR fund at the circulating area of Chaibasa station in Chakradharpur Division which has separate facilities for ladies, gents and divyangjan. Moreover, one prefabricated bio-toilet has been provided separately for ladies and gents at Chakradharpur station.
- Keeping in view the safety and convenience of the passengers, one Foot Over Bridge has been completed and commissioned at Karra station in Ranchi Division on 21.07.2021. Moreover, platform shelter of platform no. 1 at Govindpur station has also been completed during the month.
- 2 Limited Height Subways have been constructed during July 2021 with elimination of manned level crossings. 1 Limited Height Subway has been constructed in lieu of LC No. KA-129 in Indrabil-Adra Section of Adra Division, while the other has been constructed in lieu of LC No.223 in Rajgangpur Yard in Chakradharpur Division.
- Electronic Interlocking Signalling System has been commissioned at Kalunga Station in Chakradharpur Division on 03-07-2021 in connection with 3<sup>rd</sup> Line Work of Rourkela-Jharsuguda Section. Electronic Interlocking Work at Rajgangpur Station in Chakradharpur Division in connection with Rourkela-Jharsuguda 3<sup>rd</sup> Line Work and at Lodhma Station in Ranchi Division in connection with Hatia-Orga Doubling Work have also been completed on 19-07-2021 and 14-07-2021 respectively.
- 235 numbers of Cleanliness Drives were conducted during the month of July by deploying 3013 staff and 100 numbers of encroachments were removed. S E Railway ensured following of Covid Appropriate Behaviour at all railway premises and this was strictly monitored. Moreover, Medical Department continued with its regular sanitisation activities.

- SER launched the vaccination drive against Covid-19 on 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 with vaccination of the doctors and healthcare personnel. As a part of immunisation drive, during the month of July, 2021, a total of 22,210 numbers of beneficiaries were vaccinated.
- During the month of July 2021, total 7 numbers of Railway Bridges were rehabilitated.
- During the month of July 2021, total 53 criminals were arrested under RP (UP) Act with recovery of Railway property worth Rs 1,13,374/-.
- During the month of July, 2021, total 1493 offenders including 14 touts and 287 unauthorised hawkers were booked under different sections of the Railways Act and Rs 4,68,640/- was collected as fine.
- One female passenger and one child were rescued by RPF post Kharagpur from 02984 Agartala-Bengaluru Special on 07.07.2021. They were reported missing and the information was received from Assam Police. The lady, the child and the suspect with whom they were travelling were handed over to GRP Kharagpur.
- Regular drives were conducted by RPF and Commercial Department jointly during the month of July against ticketless travellers. Altogether 3309 ticketless travellers were detected and an amount of Rs.16,06,983/- was realised as fine.
- During the month of July 2021, altogether 61 Minor Boys and 61 Minor Girls were rescued by RPF Personnel of SER and handed over to their parents or Child Help Line.
