Chief Medical Superintendent, S.E.Railway, Chakradharpur, West Singhbhum, Jharkhand – 833102 hereby invites "Expression of Interest" (EOI) from the interested and reputed diagnostic centres / hospital for shortlisting the interested parties to provide Pathological test / Investigations facility (as detailed in Annexure A) to the railway beneficiaries of Divisional Railway Hospital / Chakradharpur, Sub-Divisional Hospital / BNBM & TATA along with all Health Units (JSG, DPS, ADTP, SNY, ROU, BNBM, BUF, etc.). The successful service provider(s) will formulate a mutual agreement with the Chief Medical Superintendent, Chakradharpur and will work on the basis of terms and conditions of the MOU (Memorandum of Understanding) from the date of finalisation of the MOU. The responses on the prescribed format (as enclosed the annexure B) may be submitted to **Chief Medical Superintendent, Divisional Railway Hospital, Chakradharpur, Dist- West Singhbhum, Jharkhand – 833102** by post/by hand at CMS Office, Chakradharpur along with relevant documents in sealed cover on or before **14.08.2025 at 15:30 Hrs.**

Special Terms and Conditions:-

- 1) Testing centre must be NABL/Non NABL accredited. Testing centre should have all necessary valid documents issued by regulatory bodies to operate such centres.
- 2) Testing facilities may be available in house. Rare investigations, if done from other centre must be mentioned.
- 3) All tests must be carried out by highest model & automated instruments available in the market on date maintaining the quality controls. List of instruments available in the testing centre may be submitted with EOI.
- 4) Name & educational qualifications of Doctors, Technicians etc. who are appointed / engaged at the testing centre may be submitted with EOI.
- 5) Samples to be collected mainly from the Divisional Railway Hospital / Chakradharpur, Sub-Divisional Hospital / BNBM & TATA along with all Health Units (Jharsuguda, Dangoaposi etc.) at regular working hours i.e. from 09:00 AM to 05:00 PM on daily basis at their own cost. For emergency cases outside working hours, samples are to be collected whenever required.
- 6) Routine reports to be delivered within 24 hours in Divisional Railway Hospital/Chakradharpur, Sub-Divisional Hospital/TATA & BNBM along with all Health Units (Jharsuguda, Dangoaposi etc.)/S.E.Railway. However, special investigation reports are to be delivered within the stipulated time as per NABL guidelines.
- 7) For emergency cases, e-reports to be sent to the concerned ward-in-charge immediately along with a copy to Pathology Department followed by routine delivery of reports on the next day.
- 8) The firm's representative will collect the pathology samples / specimens etc. from the OPD and IPD patients of this hospital. Phlebotomy will be performed by the firm's representative. The firm's representative will also inform the Sister-in-charge or patient / patient party of the date, time and place of delivery of reports.
- 9) The text reports will be delivered to the (i) Pathology department of Divisional Railway Hospital/Chakradharpur, Sub-Divisional Hospital/TATA & BNBM along with all Health Units (Jharsuguda, Dangoaposi etc.)/S.E.Railway in case of IPD patients and (ii) The patient / patient party in case of OPD patients. The delivery of reports shall be done under clear signature of receipt.
- 10) There shall be alternative backup arrangement in case of mechanical failure, testing not to be refused on that ground.
- 11) MOU will be valid for 01(one) year. MOU may be entered with more than one testing centers.
- 12) The services will be cashless for the patients duly referred by the Divisional Railway Hospital/Chakradharpur, Sub-Divisional Hospital/TATA & BNBM along with all Health Units (Jharsuguda, Dangoaposi etc.)/S.E.Railway. Bill are to be submitted every month along with a copy of the referral letter & report. Payment will be arranged by the Railway administration through RTGS / NEFT. Details about the Bank, Account number, Branch, IFSC code etc. to be provided for this purpose.

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- 13) The rate offered by the centers will be as per existing CGHS rate/Ranchi (NABL/Non-NABL rates) and Government Hospital (Incl. Railway) rate as per current revised rate available at AIIMS site or CGHS Kolkata if AIIMS rate not available. On receiving the EOIs, a nominated team of doctors from the Railway will inspect the diagnostic centers, if necessary. On being selected for empanelment, the diagnostic centres will be informed over phone or / and by speed post. The diagnostic centers may depute their authorised representative for signing of MOU. The Railway beneficiaries / patient will be referred to the diagnostic centre (as per the choice of the patient) with a referral letter indicating the name of the patient, designation, office, station, name of investigation to be conducted, patient's ID card number / Medical treatment identity card number will be mentioned on the said referral letter. The diagnostic center will verify the patient's ID card of the patient / Railway beneficiaries and satisfy themselves prior to conducting the test/investigations. In case of any doubt, the diagnostic center will contact the authorised person from the Railways whose name(s) and telephone number(s) will be provided at the time of signing of MOU. The bills are to be prepared in triplicate by the Diagnostic Centers on monthly basis and submitted to the office of Chief Medical Superintendent, Divisional Railway Hospital, Chakradharpur, Dist- West Singhbhum, Jharkhand - 833102 along with copies of referral letter for arranging payment. 
